STATUTORY UPDATES

- The DfE are seeking views on proposed changes to the non-statutory elective home education guidance for local authorities and parents. This consultation closes on 18 January 2024
- The DfE says, education standards continue to improve as new statistics on the phonics screening check (published 12/10/23) show 79% of 5 & 6 year olds met the expected standard, up from 75% last year.
- The DfE says, as of 27th October, LAs should be receiving details of their allocation from the £289 million wraparound childcare fund, to make sure families of primary school children can access childcare between 8-6pm.
- Two thirds of school inspection grades now match performance outcomes according to Ofsted analysis. Inspectors didn't take exam results into account during the pandemic, but are slowly returning to using data in inspections (Schools Week)
- Ofsted have confirmed that it will no longer be carrying out summary evaluations of MATs until the next financial year (therefore until April 2025). It is believed that this will allow Ofsted to focus their capacity on school inspections which it is legally required to undertake.

TRUST & SCHOOL SELF-REVIEW

Our CEO and other key members of the Trust met with the National Leaders of Governance to undertake a self-review audit to benchmark what we do against national expectations. This was a very useful exercise that has supported us to identify how we can further improve our skills.

Skills audits have been conducted for LACs that were current at the beginning of the academic year, for those who have joined after that, a link to the form will be coming your way.





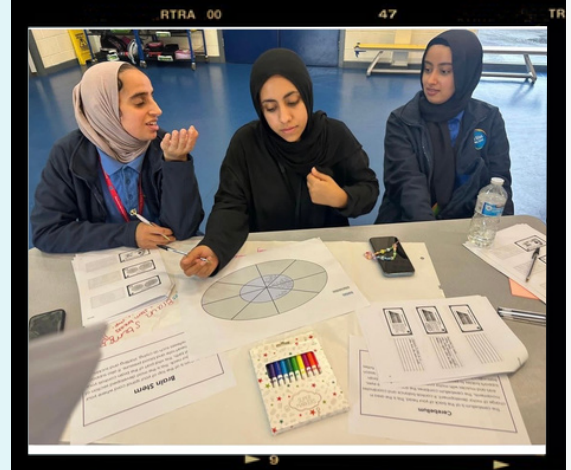
CROXTETH PRIMARY SCHOOL

REMAT EARLY YEARS LSA CPD PROGRAMME

As we continue our commitment to quality CPD in the early years we are running an Early Years LSA CPD Programme that all early years LSAs are completing this academic year. This will support LSAs to further their knowledge skills in child development, the prime areas of learning and early literacy. This will ensure to all our practitioners are developing experts in early years education. We are pleased to announce our Year 1 Phonics Screening success. Last academic year all our schools were above the national average of 79% and our Trust average being 10% above national at 89%.
