## Special Mention

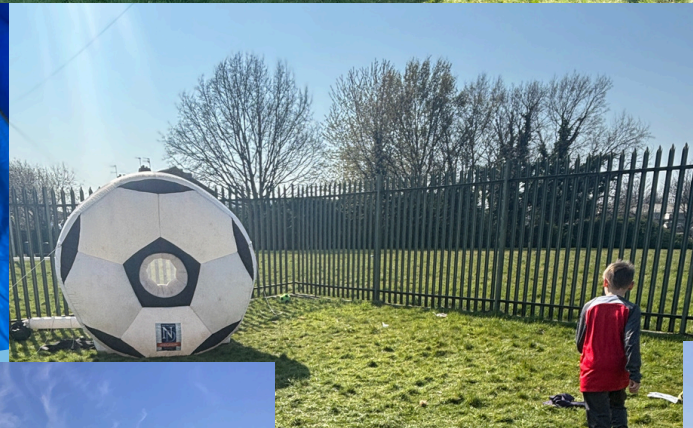
