We feel very strongly that achieving in PE is very important.

We expect all children to wear the school PE kit and all of our staff who teach or support in PE lessons wear the school kit too.

Our PE Curriculum:

A wide range of PE is delivered to the pupils, which aims to engage and inspire all pupils. We are fully committed to ensuring that all pupils receive 2 hours of high-quality, well-planned PE per week, delivered by confident and well-trained staff. We have an up-to-date PE Scheme of work to reflect the requirements of the National Curriculum.

Sustainability:

We aim to use this money to create a sustainable curriculum for all children. Some of the money provided by the funding will be invested in the professional development of staff and as a result will enhance the quality of teaching for all children. We invite different specialists into our school, who coach teachers and work alongside them in a range of sports. Due to their influence and expertise, all teachers will have the chance to develop their teaching of P.E. and will team teach with a specialist to increase knowledge, skills and confidence.

Partnership Work / Competitions: Our school contributes to Knowsley School Sports Partnership.

As well as our regular PE lessons, we hold inter-trust competitions and annual sports-days for EYFS, KS1 and KS2 and competitions at LA level. Children across KS2 also attend swimming lessons.

Participation: The school is keen to provide a wide range of extra-curricular clubs for pupils. A full range of clubs is available on the school website. More Able: Talented children are signposted to local clubs.
